## Other Notes

- The School estimates the following additional costs as a guide only. Uniforms \$1500, text books and stationery \$500, camps \$300.
- Camps, special excursions, non-compulsory subject-related items and optional activities will be charged on an individual basis and shown as separate items on the fee account.
- Co-curricular uniforms will need to be purchased separately depending on your daughter's area of interest.
- All fees and charges quoted are exclusive of Goods and Services Tax (GST), except for registration fees and a portion of boarding fees relating to the provision of meals, which both attract GST.
- As required by Australian law, medical insurance must be purchased for a student on a student visa.
- The School Fees Policy is available on the School's website. Fee schedules are reviewed and approved annually by the governing body and published in advance of the forthcoming calendar year. Fees may be subject to change without notice.
- A term's notice in writing, in accordance with the *Agreement with the School*, is required if the student is to be withdrawn from the School, otherwise one term's fee will be charged in lieu of notice.
- Fee Accounts issued will outline a variety of payment options. Payment via Parent Lounge is our preferred payment option (Note: Credit Card payments attract a 1.5% surcharge). BPay is also available, as outlined on Fee Accounts. All cheques should be made payable to 'Somerville House'.
